TITLE: Financial Literacy is a Construct; An Ordered Logit Approximation in Mexico

ABSTRACT: The research aims to determine the variables that explain the degree of financial literacy in the Mexican population, adding to the lack of microeconomic studies about the topic in this country, analyzing financial literacy as a construct according to the definition of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development. Due to the lack of normal distribution in the financial literacy index, an Ordered Logistic Model is used based on the nature of the ordered-categorical-multiple dependent variable, divided into low, intermediate, and high levels. The independent variables are classified based on economic, socio-behavioral, and institutional characteristics. The results show that the main variables explaining financial literacy are income level, mobile phone tenure, sex, age, and town size. Economic variables generate the most significant impact on the Mexican population; however, there are relevant results within the young population (between 18 and 35 years old) who are more likely to have higher financial literacy than people over 65, ranked with lower financial literacy. Also, in the female population, it is shown that they are more likely to have greater financial literacy than men. Regarding the institutional approach, people living in urban areas are more likely to have greater financial literacy than rural ones.
